

AAUP-KSU CONGRATULATES THE FACULTY

As Kent State University holds its 17th Annual Conference Celebrating College Teaching, it is appropriate to recognize the contributions of all faculty toward recent University achievements, such as the University's recent listing in *The Times of London* Top 200 World University Ranking for 2010-2011.

Conducted by Thompson Reuters, *The Times of London* survey used five criteria, but the most highly valued were:

- teaching, worth 30 percent of the final ranking score;
- research, rated by volume and reputation, worth 30 percent;
- citations, measured by the extent of the influence of the research, worth 32.5 percent.

These scoring measures (92.5 percent of the total score) are directly tied to the excellence of our faculty as teachers and scholars. Kent State University's faculty deserve recognition and praise for their efforts, which resulted in the University's ranking among the top 200 universities in the world.
