Founded in 1915, the AAUP is the oldest and most recognized organization for representing the interests of faculty in higher education. Through AAUP membership, individuals support the advancement of professional goals and become eligible for other benefits.

The most important benefit of membership is the right to vote on such issues as future collective bargaining agreements, the election of department campus representatives to the AAUP-KSU Council, which is the governing body of the Chapter, and future AAUP-KSU Presidents. Additionally, members are able to participate and serve on AAUP-KSU committees. As a Chapter member, you will automatically become a member of the national AAUP, which is a professional organization known for its defense of academic freedom and tenure. Also, as an AAUP member, you will receive a subscription to *Academe*, which in addition to regular topical articles, publishes an annual survey of faculty salaries.
